The Story so Far...

- Extensive consultation in 2008 to define the role of the Central Library
- Resulted in the Building Program "A Partnership of Culture and Learning"
- Funding secured from three levels of government
- Council approved the project and funding plan
- Council approved engagement of architects











Funding Summary

Government of Canada \$18.3 million (Building Canada Program)

Province of Nova Scotia \$13.0 million

Halifax Regional Municipality \$23.7 million

TOTAL \$55.0 million
